Having sourced grapes from this magnificent property for more than five years. Paul is no stranger to Goldrock Ridge Vineyard. "Finding a vineyard like Goldrock Ridge is like finding a rare diamond", states Hobbs. The vineyard has consistently earned awards for environmentally sound development and farming, making the acquisition an ideal fit for Hobbs, whose vineyard holdings across West Sonoma County and the Napa Valley were all recently certified sustainable by the Certified California Sustainable Winegrowing Alliance. "I can hardly begin to describe the anticipation and excitement we all share to have our highly experienced and skilled vineyard team take on its oversight", contributes Hobbs.

Located on the south side of Annapolis Road, Goldrock Ridge Vineyard joins Paul Hobbs' collection of esteemed estates including Edward James, Ellen Lane, Katherine Lindsay and Ross Station in the Russian River Valley and Nathan Coombs in Coombsville, the newest subappellation of Napa Valley (2011).
